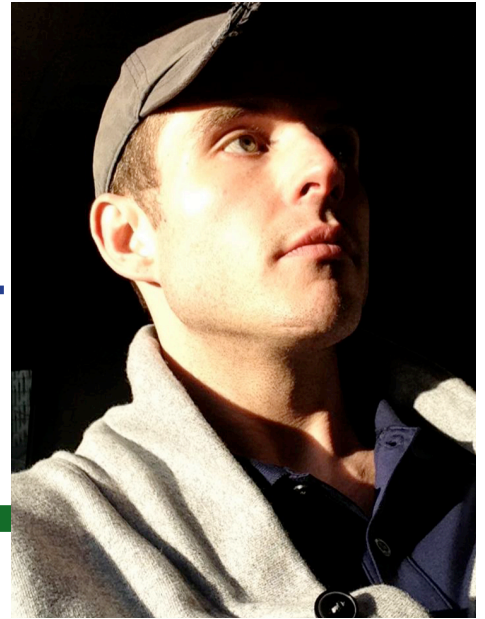
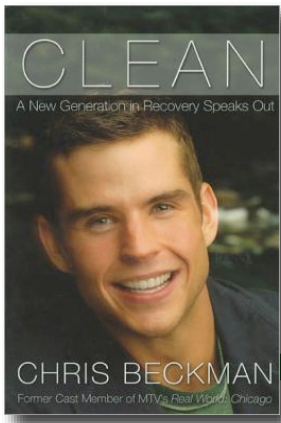


CHRISTOPHER BECKMAN: AN OPEN TALK ABOUT SUBSTANCE ABUSE
