Sample Accommodations Statement for Syllabi

The following is a sample statement which IUP's Department for Disability Access and Advising (D^2A^2) recommends that professors include in their syllabi in order to inform students with disabilities about the initial steps they would need to take in order to register their disability with IUP and to make use of academic accommodations.

All discussions will remain confidential.

You must be registered with the Department for Disability Access and Advising (D²A²), and requested them to provide your accommodation letter to me, before I can accommodate you.
