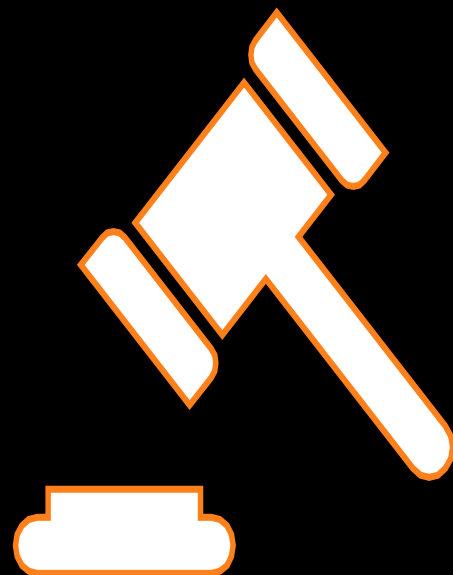

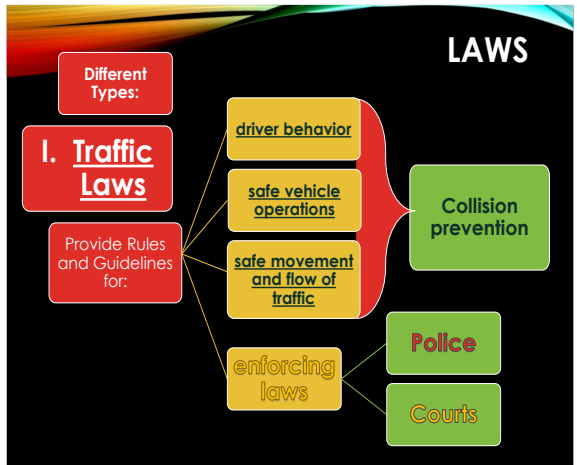
- These resources are based on a behind the wheel program that is used by trained driver education teachers.

- To provide objectives and methods similar to those used by in-car driving instructors that may:
 - reduce stressful situations for adult and teen.
 - reduce risk by allowing the teen driver to gradually progress through skill levels and driving environments.
 - The "Be Ready, Be Safe, Be Responsible" approach, is the motto used by the Novice Driver Statewide Program, and is used in the PA Perceptual Driving Curriculum.

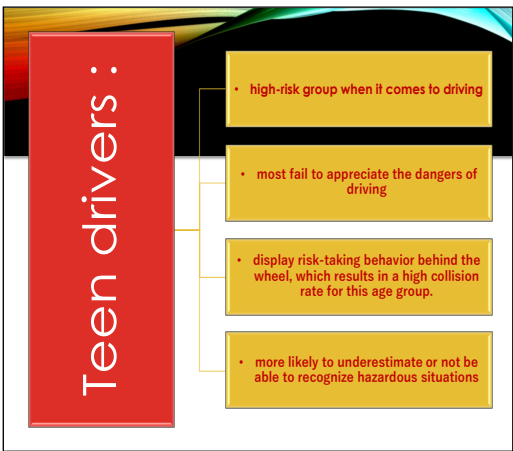

Teen drivers :
 Are a high-risk group when it comes to driving.
 Most fail to appreciate the dangers of driving
 display risk-taking behavior behind the wheel, which results in a high collision rate for this age group.
 More likely to underestimate or not be able to recognize hazardous situations

TEEN DRIVERS :

In 2017 Nationwide:

2,364 teens aged 16-19 were killed
(CDC, WISQARS)

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TEEN DRIVERS :

2017 In Pennsylvania:

6,758 teen drivers aged 16 -17 were involved in a vehicle crash

40 were involved in fatal crashes

Since 1999-
181,243 teen drivers were involved in crashes

1,351 of these were involved in fatal crashes

STEPS TAKEN TO COMBAT THESE FACTORS:
GRADUATED DRIVER LICENSING (GDL)

Adopted by PA in 1999

Helps new drivers gain skills under lower-risk conditions

- Stage 2: **Junior license (provisional license)**
- Stage 3: **Unrestricted license**

PA GDL LEARNER'S PERMIT

STAGE 1

Learner's Permit

- issued to applicants who are at least 16 years of age and
- have successfully completed a physical examination,
- vision screening, and
- driving knowledge test.

PA GDL LEARNER'S PERMIT

- w/10 hrs. night &
- 5 hrs. bad weather

Proper supervision with:

- licensed driver at least 21 years of age
- licensed parent, guardian, person in loco parentis or spouse at least 18 years old

PA GDL-JUNIOR LICENSE STAGE 2

JUNIOR LICENSE – AFTER PASSING THE DRIVING TEST, ALLOWS UNSUPERVISED DRIVING WITH RESTRICTIONS:

- NO NIGHTTIME DRIVING BETWEEN 11 P.M. AND 5 A.M. ***
- NUMBER OF PASSENGERS MUST NOT EXCEED THE NUMBER OF SEATBELTS IN THE VEHICLE.**
- PASSENGER RESTRICTIONS: NO MORE THAN ONE (1) PASSENGER UNDER THE AGE OF 18 WHO IS NOT AN IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBER UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY DRIVER'S PARENT/GUARDIAN.**
- AFTER 6 MONTHS ON A JUNIOR LICENSE, THE LIMIT IS INCREASED TO: NO MORE THAN 3 PASSENGERS UNDER THE AGE OF 18 WHO ARE NOT IMMEDIATE FAMILY MEMBERS UNLESS ACCOMPANIED BY ONE OF YOUR PARENTS**

PA GDL-Junior License

Stage 2

Junior License – After passing the driving test, allows unsupervised driving with restrictions:

No nighttime driving between 11 p.m. and 5 a.m. *

Number of passengers must not exceed the number of seatbelts in the vehicle.

Passenger restrictions: no more than one (1) passenger under the age of 18 who is not an immediate family member unless accompanied by driver's parent/guardian.

After 6 months on a junior license, the limit is increased to: no more than 3 passengers under the age of 18 who are not immediate family members unless accompanied by one of your parents

PA GDL-UNRESTRICTED LICENSE STAGE 3

Unrestricted License

- Issued at age 18 –
- Unlimited driving privileges to teens who have progressed through the graduated system and have a history of safe driving.

Unrestricted license before age 18:

- crash- and conviction-free for 12 months
- completed an approved driver's education course
- submit special form **DL-59** to PennDOT with a certificate of completion from an approved driver's education course.
- An affidavit of consent from a parent, guardian, person in loco parentis or spouse who is at least 18 years of age must also be provided.

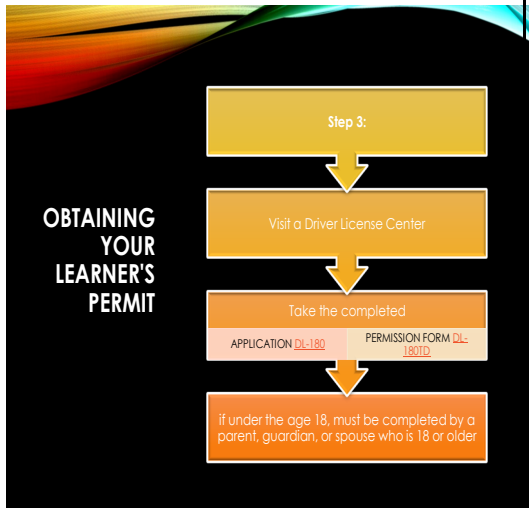

PRACTICE, PRACTICE, PRACTICE

- Complete and log the mandatory minimum hours of practice driving time. (At least 60 hours, 10 hours nighttime, 5 hours bad weather.) These are the minimum time recommendations.

Once the requirements are met, and the parent of guardian allows, the student may take the license test.

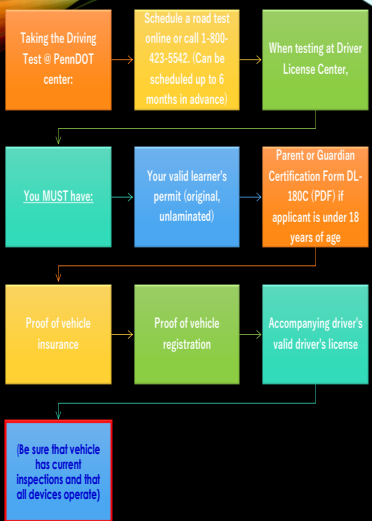

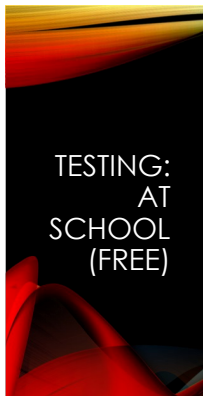

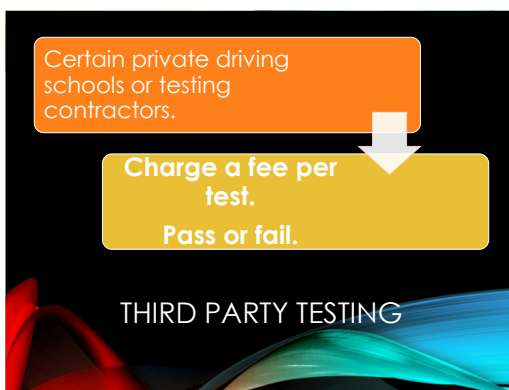

TAKING THE ROAD TEST

Vehicle Controls:

- Operate horn, all lights, windshield wipers, parking brake, 4-way flashers, defroster, etc.
- Failure to operate any of the vehicle controls will result in a failure of the Road Test.

Parallel Park:

- Park your vehicle midway between two uprights in a space that is 24 feet long and eight (8) feet wide.
- Your entire vehicle must be completely inside the space
- You have one attempt to park using no more than three adjustments.

Taking the Road Test

Vehicle Controls:

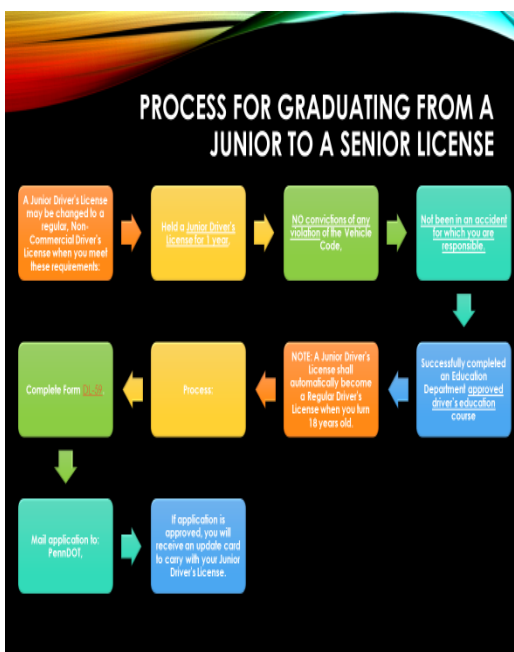


LICENSE TESTING

If the novice driver fails:
 If under the age of 18- Must wait 7 days to re-test
 If over 18, may retest as soon as it is practical to do so.
 The tester will sign and date your permit as a failure.
 After three failures: Driver must reapply for a permit extension.



When you pass, if at a PennDOT center, receive your picture license
 If testing through school, the teacher will sign and stamp your permit. This is now a valid license until you receive a "camera card" in the mail from PennDOT,
 then, get Photo License at a PennDOT License Center.
 Your fee has already been paid when getting permit.



Process for Graduating from a Junior to a Senior License
 A Junior Driver's License may be changed to a regular, Non-Commercial Driver's License when you meet these requirements:

- Held a Junior Driver's License for 1 year,
- NO convictions of any violation of the Vehicle Code,
- Not been in an accident for which you are responsible.
- Successfully completed an Education Department approved driver's education course

NOTE: A Junior Driver's License shall automatically become a Regular Driver's License when you turn 18 years old.
