

Part II. Description of Curriculum Change

1. Catalog Description:

BIOL 203 Principles of Genetics and Development 3c-3l-4cr

Prerequisite: BIOL 202 or instructor permission

An introduction to the science of genetics, with an emphasis on the basic principles of Mendelian genetics, the genetics of populations, molecular genetics, and the genetics of development. For science majors.

2. Proposed Changes:

BIOL 203 Principles of Genetics and Development 3c-3l-4cr

Prerequisite: BIOL 202 or 111 or instructor permission

Introduces the science of genetics, with an emphasis on the basic principles of Mendelian genetics, the genetics of populations, molecular genetics, and the genetics of development. For science majors.

3. Justification/rationale for the changes:

The Biology Department adopted a new curriculum in Fall 2014. BIOL 202 replaces BIOL 111 and BIOL 203 replaces BIOL 263. Furthermore, students that completed BIOL 111 or BIOL 202 now continue on to BIOL 203. However, students who completed BIOL 111 are not able to enroll in BIOL 203 because of the current prerequisites.
