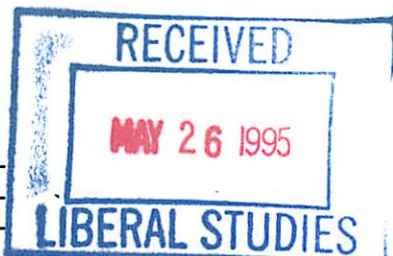

A. Catalog Description

BC 401 Laboratory Methods in Biology and Biotechnology 2c-4l-3sh

Prerequisites: CH 351 or BC 302

Theory and practice in a number of major analytical and preparative techniques currently in use in physiology, molecular biology, and biotechnology.

B. Proposed Changes

Old title and new title are the same. Old number BI 401; new number BC 401. Prerequisite change from CH 351 to CH 351 or BC 302.

C. Justification/Rationale for the Change(s)

Justification for the change is that the Biology Department is not able to offer the course every AY which is a requirement for all junior biochemistry program majors. Therefore, with a BC identification, individuals from either biology or chemistry can teach the course. In fact, last AY the course was taught by a qualified member of the Chemistry Department.
