3. Justification

Name Change:

It is critically important in the field of

deafness to be current in the use of the terminology reflective of the field and course. The currently accepted terminology to describe the language that is being taught in this course is: American Sign Language (abbreviated ASL). The name change is more reflective of the course content and focus. This is the first course at the intermediate level and therefore is indicated by the number I in the title.

Number Change:

This course is intended to be one of several language courses, which synthesizes the information learned during EDHL 115. It is appropriate for this course to have a 200 level designation to more clearly represent the level at which the course should be taken. It also more appropriately denotes that it falls within the sign language sequence of 115, 215, 216, 315, 316, and 415.

Prerequisite Change:

The Pennsylvania State Department of Education currently mandates that students maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA in all major courses and in their coursework overall.
