Part II Description of the Curriculum Change – Name-Prerequisite Change

1. Old Catalog Description:

EDHL 329 Hearing Practicum I

var-1sh

Prerequisites: EDHL 114, 115, 2.5 GPA

Provides the student with actual contact with individuals with hearing loss. Practica will be set up in appropriate school programs and/or clinics for the hearing impaired, in hearing itinerant programs, or in clinical settings where hearing-impaired individuals are receiving therapy or are being tested. Techniques of observing and evaluating behavior are presented initially to prepare the student to profit maximally from the observation experiences. Written reports of the practica are submitted and discussed, and each student is encouraged to gain experience in as many different settings as available.

New Catalog Description:

EDHH 329 Teaching - Collaborative Practicum I

var - 1cr

Prerequisites: EDHH 114, 115, 215, 216, 360, 3.0 GPA

Provides the students with actual contact with children who are deaf or hard of hearing. Practica will be set up in appropriate school/clinic/itinerant programs where the academic needs of students who are deaf or hard of hearing are being addressed. Behavioral observation and collaboration skills are developed initially to prepare students to work in instructional pairs. Guidance in the development and execution of lesson plans is provided. Instructional collaboration is emphasized. Written reports of the practica are submitted and discussed.

Justification

Name Change:

Since the implementation of Public Law 94-142 in 1975, the number of children who are deaf or hard of hearing and attend self-contained schools for the deaf has significantly decreased. The nature of the job of a teacher of persons who are deaf or hard of hearing has changed as more children attend classes in regular public schools rather than schools for the deaf. Teachers must now be able to successfully collaborate with a number of other professionals who work with their students. It is critical that pre-service

teachers receive specific training and practice in the skills needed for successful collaboration. This course continues to focus on pre-service students learning how to teach children who are deaf or hard of hearing and now adds a formal focus in collaboration skills. The name change more clearly reflects the nature of the course content and focus.

Prerequisite Change:

Three additional sign language classes have been added to the course sequence. Two of these courses are to be taken prior to enrollment in EDHH 329. In addition, the general methods course has been split into two courses, one taken prior to EDHH 329 and one taken concurrently with EDHH 329.

The Pennsylvania State Department of Education currently mandates that students maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA in all major courses and in their coursework overall.
