3. Name Justification

It is critically important in the field of deafness to be current in the use of the terminology reflective of the field. The currently accepted terminology to describe individuals who have a type of hearing loss is: Deaf and Hard of Hearing (abbreviated D/HH). The names of all major courses should reflect the current terminology. The change in the name of the course more appropriately reflects the content and focus of the course.

Number Justification

This course is offered as a capstone sign language class along with other senior-level courses. Therefore, the number change reflects its status as a terminal course.

Pre-requisite Justification

The student must complete all of the sign language courses in the sequence in order to be appropriately fluent in American Sign Language skills. In addition, a 3.0 GPA is required overall and in the major as mandated by the PDE.
