Part II. Description of Catalog Description Change

1. Current Catalog Description

EDUC 452 Teaching English and Communication in the Secondary School 3c-01-3cr

Prerequisite: ENGL 314, 323, and 380 and admission to Student Teaching

A prerequisite to student teaching in English. Introduces current professional practices in the teaching of English and communications in high school.

Proposed Catalog Description

EDUC 452 Teaching English and Communication in Secondary School 3c-01-3cr

Prerequisite: ENGL 314, 323, and 324 and admission to Step 1 of the 3-Step Process

A prerequisite to student teaching in English. Introduces current professional practices in the teaching of English and communications in secondary school.

2. Proposed changes

- a. One prerequisite deleted (380) and one prerequisite added (324)
- b. Change “introduces current professional practices in the teaching of English and communications in secondary school.

3. Justification for change

- a. Prerequisite ENGL380 is no longer offered.
- b. Because methods courses ENGL 314 and 323 are included as prerequisites, ENGL 324 Teaching and Evaluating Writing, another methods course taken prior to EDUC 452, should also be a prerequisite.
- c. The designation “high school” in the current catalog description is not as accurate as “secondary school,” as graduates will be certified to teach grades 7 – 12.
