New Catalog Description

ENGL 326 Creative Writing: Fiction

3c-01-3cr

Prerequisite: ENGL 221 or instructor permission

A writing workshop for students who wish to focus intensively on the writing and revision of fiction and on developing an audience for one's creative work.

Old Catalog Description

ENGL 326 Creative Writing: Fiction

3c-01-3cr

Prerequisite: ENGL 221, instructor permission based on samples of student's work A writing workshop for students who wish to write fiction under the guidance of an instructor. Focuses intensively on the writing and revision of prose fiction and on developing an audience for one's work.

Justification/Rationale for the Change:

We have changed the prerequisite to clarify that students need to have ENGL 221: Creative Writing OR permission from the instructor. It is not current practice to screen students based on their work samples. Students sign up based on the ENGL 221 prerequisite. However, we want the instructor to have the option to waive the prerequisite based on evidence that the student has the skills to succeed.
