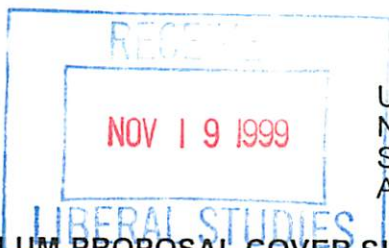

Ethical issues and international law are integrated throughout the course.
