Why is the course being revised/deleted:	<p>At one point the prerequisite for the class was at least 12 credits of geography courses. The only prerequisite course for content is GEOG 230 Cultural Geography. The other courses listed are the other required core courses that come before GEOG 411, which were there mainly for sequencing. For many years this course was offered in the fall semester and GEOG 412 Research Seminar (GEOG 411 is a prerequisite for 412) in the spring semester, but in 2009-2010 the classes switched semesters so that students in GEOG 412 could complete their research project and consider presenting at the IUP Undergraduate Scholars Forum in the spring semester. The switch has achieved that goal but it has made it more difficult for students to be able to complete all of the prerequisite/corequisites for GEOG 411 before the spring semester of their Junior year. By changing the prerequisites to GEOG 230 and at least 9 other GEOG credits it will make it easier for students to register in GEOG 411.</p> <p>Prominent scholars is being added to the description because it was one important component of the course missing from the current description.</p>
