Presents concepts of city, subdivision, and transportation design in relation to topography, natural resources, and other physical elements.

2) Summary of the proposed revisions.

Department prefix, course title and number change. From GE 463 Planning: Design to RP 354 Planning Design.

Note: The prerequisite is the same as before (Introduction to Planning), but the prefix and number of Introduction to Planning is being changed from GE 360 to RP 350 in a parallel proposal.

3) Justification.

The department prefix is being changed to more clearly identify the Regional Planning courses. This change will improve graduation check out and move us toward our goal of accreditation. The course title is being changed to simplify it and so that it is parallel to the other titles. The number is being changed to accommodate curriculum changes, clarify course sequence, and insure consistency in format.
