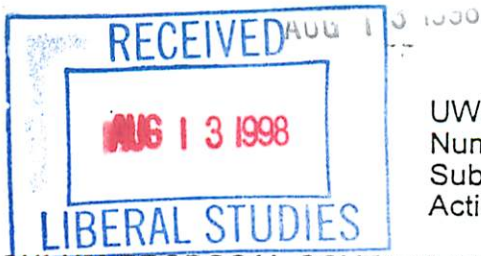

Not open to History and Secondary Social Science Education majors. An examination of the development of civilization in Europe during the ancient and medieval periods. The characteristics and institutions of civilization will be stressed as well as the political history.

HI 212            Ancient and Medieval Europe            3c-01-3sh
