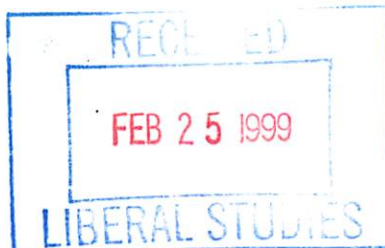

History of China and Japan from ancient times, Buddhism, medieval Japan; Chinese Communism, industrialization. Some consideration of peripheral Asia from 1500 will be addressed.

3. Justification for the Change(s)

Title is changed because the term "Far East" suggests a Eurocentric view of Asia and is no longer commonly used.

Course number is changed to bring the course into the same general numerical grouping as two other departmental offerings which deal with aspects of Asian History, HI 330 (History of Islamic Civilization) and HI 331 (Modern Middle East).

This course has been offered in 1996-50, 1997-50, and 1998-50. Prior to that it was not offered for a number of years and became inactive. For some reason, even though it is being offered currently, it has not reappeared in the catalog.
