I. Catalog Description

INDS 118 Interior Design Graphics

**1 class hour
3 lab hours
3 credits
(1c-3l-3cr)**

Introduces two- and three-dimensional graphic skills, including basic drawing, drafting, delineating, perspective drawing; applies principles and elements of design; stresses graphic design and layout.

Course objectives:

- Apply principles and elements of design to creating project documentation.
- Solve design problems utilizing drafting and other graphic skills
- Visually describe design solutions by applying drafting, perspective drawing, sketching and other fundamental graphic skills.
- Interpret three-dimensional relationships two-dimensionally.
- Demonstrate an understanding of perspective drawing to solve design problems and communicate solutions.
- Apply graphic standards rules affecting such sheet elements as symbols, representations of furniture, fixtures, and equipment, letter and numeral design, sentence layout, paragraph construction, and sheet organization.
- State design solutions and other information during oral presentations of design.
- Apply fundamental understanding of structure and materials to solving design problems graphically.
- Interpret design criticisms from others constructively during presentations, and, in the same positive vein, assess design solutions of others during critiques.
