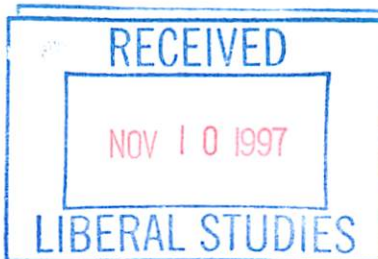

FC 250 Introduction to Teaching Vocational Family and Consumer Sciences Education

FC 250 Introduction to Teaching Vocational Family 3c-01-3sh and Consumer Sciences Education

Opportunities for planned observations and varied teaching experiences using a variety of resource materials are provided. Self-evaluation relative to desirable teacher competencies is stressed.
