New Course Description

1. HPED 280 Aquatic Facilities Management

2c-01-2cr

Prerequisites: None

An organizational and administrative course to prepare the aquatic professional for management of indoor and outdoor facilities. Includes facility design, safety procedures activity, and sport and recreational aspects.

Old Course Description

2. HPED 280 Aquatic Facilities Management

2c-01-2cr

Prerequisites: HPED 264

An organizational and administrative course to prepare the aquatic professional for management of indoor and outdoor facilities. Includes facility design, safety procedures activity, and sport and recreational aspects. Taught in Summer only.

Justification for the Change

Many professionals in the sport management field are employed at venues that have a swimming pool at the complex. These students need the management principles that are unique to swimming pool operation but do not need the swimming expertise that the previous prerequisite provided. The North American Society of Sport Management (NASSM) includes sport facilities management expertise in their standards but not swimming expertise.
