Proposed Change: Add a prerequisite requiring a HPED or PESP major to take the class.

## Justification for Change

3. HPED 175 is a core course that students need to take early in their academic careers to allow them to progress through their curriculum in a timely manner. It is a course in high demand among freshmen, sophomores and transfer HPED and PESP majors. By limiting the course to majors only, it will help ensure that those who need the course will have the opportunity to schedule it.
