II. 1. OLD CATALOG DESCRIPTION (2009-2010) PREREQUISITE

MUSC 218 Keyboard Harmony II 1c-1l-1cr

Prerequisite: MUSC 217

Keyboard Harmony II is a continuation of Keyboard Harmony I, involving chromatic harmony and more complex progressions.

2. PROPOSED PREREQUISITE CHANGE

MUSC 218 Keyboard Harmony II 1c-1l-1cr

Prerequisite: MUSC 217, with a grade of C or better or Satisfactory.

Keyboard Harmony II is a continuation of Keyboard Harmony I, involving chromatic harmony and more complex progressions.

The proposed change to the prerequisite is MUSC 217, with a grade of C or better or Satisfactory, changed from the old catalog prerequisite which was MUSC 217.

3. The justification for the change is so that the this Theory course, required of music majors, will be listed the same as the other Theory and Theory Skills courses, and have as prerequisite a grade of C or better or Satisfactory in the previous level required course.
