Summary of Proposed 120 Credit Change for a B.S. Degree in Nursing

At our May 6, 2002 faculty meeting, the faculty voted to eliminate Medical Physics PHYS 151/161 from our list of required courses for nursing majors. The deletion of PHYS 151 decreases our designated liberal studies course list by 3 credits. The deletion of PHYS 161 eliminates the lab for this course as well.

After much discussion within the department, which included a review of trended aggregate student and alumni data, surveys of various nursing programs, and discussion with our Student Advisory Board, it was determined that the course no longer served the needs of the beginning graduate nurse. Furthermore, it was felt that the important components of that course that related to nursing were covered in BIOL 151 Human Physiology and in the core nursing courses. This integrated inclusion of physics content across the student's program of studies serves to fulfill the requirement by the Pennsylvania State Board of Nursing which mandates that the general curriculum requirement for Baccalaureate, Associate degree, and Diploma programs "...shall include content from the areas of anatomy and physiology, chemistry, microbiology, physics and nutrition, which may be integrated, combined or presented as separate courses;..." Representatives from the Department of Nursing and Allied Health Professions did meet with representatives from the Department of Physics and faculty from the Department of Physics met with and discussed this course change with faculty in the Department of Nursing and Allied Health Professions (on two separate occasions). The department believes it has openly met with and discussed this program revision with the affected department. See attached email notification as well.
