#### **COMPONENTS OF NONVERBAL COMMUNICATION**

<u>Facial expressions</u> <u>Eye behavior</u> <u>Posture</u> <u>Gesture</u>

Rhythm and tempo of movement Proxemics Vocal expression

#### **COMPONENTS OF VOCAL EXPRESSION**

<u>Pitch</u> - The variance between high and low sounds

<u>Cadence</u> - The rhythm of speech, incorporating the duration of silence between words and phrases

**Tempo** -The pace at which you speak

#### Volume

**Emphasis** - The separation of words or phrases from the main body of speech by the use of cadence, tempo or volume

#### Timbre

The 'quality' of vocal sound
