Student Application for Dual Baccalaureate Degree

If you have earned a minimum of 28 undergraduate credits from IUP and are in good academic standing, you may complete this application to pursue a second baccalaureate degree concurrently with the first.

To be awarded two degrees, the following criteria must be met.

- You must earn at least 30 credits beyond the requirements of the primary program of study and a minimum of 150 credits to receive both degrees concurrently.
You may not be graduated until both degrees are completed.
All requirements for the curriculum of each degree must be satisfied.
A course required in both degree programs does not need to be repeated for the second degree.
All university requirements, such as minimum GPA and number of residency credits taken at IUP in the major, must be met separately for each degree.
If you elect to discontinue the pursuit of receiving dual baccalaureate degrees simultaneously and apply for graduation with one degree, you will be bound to the second baccalaureate degree requirements if a later return to IUP is desired to pursue another undergraduate degree.

Note: The standard procedure at IUP is to NOT list majors on diplomas, only the degree awarded.
