For convenience, all courses offered in an online/hybrid format. Admission is open enrollment, meaning you can apply at any time for a summer start. Complete your PhD in half the time. As 27 credits from a DNP degree transfer to this innovative PhD, coursework is completed in a highly accelerated format, requiring only 33 semester hours of graduate credits to complete the DNP to PhD degree as opposed to the 60 hours required of the traditional nursing PhD.


CAREER OUTCOMES
