Students develop knowledge of the ethical, financial, economic, social, and legal aspects of the sport industry. Graduates can seek employment in school and college athletic departments, coaching, community recreation organizations, professional sport franchises, commercial sport facilities, the YMCA system, and the golf industry, as well as other athletic and sport-related industries.
