IUP Health Service

HS can provide you with private, confidential medical care including a free medical exam, emergency contraception, STI/HIV prevention medication, STI testing, pregnancy testing, counseling resources, advocacy options and follow up care.

If you choose to go to IRMC ER, we can provide transportation M-F 8-4:30.

IRMC ER

IRMC ER can offer emergency medical care, including medical exam, emergency contraception, STI testing, STI/HIV prevention medication, pregnancy testing, advocacy, and forensic examination/collection kit, drug and alcohol testing.

The ER will bill your insurance or may use Victim Compensation Funds for payment of services.

The ER is **required** to report the assault to police but is your decision to pursue charges.

Considerations

- Physical evidence collection (Rape Kit) can be completed up to 5 days after a sexual assault
- Medications to prevent STI's and pregnancy can also be given up to 5 days after an assault (HIV prevention medication nPEP must be taken within 72 hours)
