



You will need to set-up your personal account in MyIUP. Be sure to select a password that you will remember.






Using the **Academics** Tab explore all of our academic majors. Check out your academic profile listed here – confirm your major and your admit term.

Take time to watch a few videos – these will help you to learn a little more about IUP.








Once your Financial Aid award is complete you will find your award letter on this tab.



## What to expect at Orientation

**Freshmen Orientation** is a two-day, overnight experience where students have the opportunity to:

- Learn more about IUP and college life
- Meet with an advisor in your major
- Plan and Register for your first semester

**Transfer Orientation** is a one-day experience focused on course advisement and registration.

All incoming students are required to attend Orientation.

A separate **Parent/Family Orientation** program is also available for any parent, guardian or family member who would like to accompany the student to their orientation.

Summer 2020 Orientation dates take place throughout the month of June. Early 2020 Orientation programs will be held in March and April.
