Dr. Padgett, a dynamic and energetic presenter, will kick off a university-wide discussion about High Impact Practices (HIPs): the ten best practices in-and out-of-the-classroom that have been shown to be highly beneficial to the success of college students on Nov. 8. He will remain on campus to present our Reflective Practice Saturday Workshop on November 9.

Dr. Padgett will address three of the HIPs specifically mentioned as topics of interest in our Reflective Practice planning survey: Collaborative assignments and projects, involving undergraduates in activities to enhance scholarly engagement, and development of faculty-student creative/research projects. He will discuss both the “why” and the “how” of these practices and will offer effective strategies we can incorporate into our courses.
