NCAE Cybergames announcements/recruitment was carried out briefly:

 Many students in attendance are confirmed to have already signed up to participate in the NCAE games

- Those in attendance who are not currently signed up were offered a chance to attend and sign up for the competition with the Cybersecurity Club
- New CSA funds to attend the cybersecurity conference have been allocated for students
 - o Approval for the specific conference needs to be made by the PI
 - Documentation of all purchases for reimbursement need to be recorded and provided to the PI prior to travel and after travel to confirm expenditure
 - The limit of the funds is \$1,750.00
 - The grant ends in August, and so the money would need to be reimbursed before that time
 - Students are advised to choose conferences that will occur before
 May (before the end of the academic semester)
 - Currently, the grant is available for a single-use/year
 - Would need approved as well for the following year in order to be used next year
- Students were given an opportunity to ask questions regarding the scholarship
 - Full-time status is required to get funding by the DoD for returning scholars
 - Students that are not going to be graduating this spring need to continue to be enrolled full-time
 - Was previously confirmed in the meeting by all students that have this requirement
 - Using book funds
 - Book funds can be allocated in the spring towards paying for exams
 - However, students must pay for the material and exam vouchers themselves
 - Pass the exam
 - And only then will they be reimbursed
 - E-readers can also be purchased with this money at the end of the spring
 - Will be discussed further on a later date
 - Letters of Recommendation are required by the PI for returning scholars
- Students should anticipate a deadline on the CSA portfolio, and should begin compiling their works for the semester
 - o Deadline will be announced around the time of the next meeting
