PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

IMMERSIVE ACTIVITIES

Many culturally-based activities have been offered to allow participants to practice their language skills and immerse themselves in Chinese culture:

- Meals at Chinese restaurants.
- Dragon Boat Paddling Excursion in Pittsburgh, PA.
- Chinese waist drum dancing demonstration and practice.
- Field trips to Chinatowns in Washington, DC and Philadelphia, PA.
- Cooking lessons on traditional Chinese cuisine and techniques.
- Visits to museums featuring exhibits on Chinese artifacts, art, and history.

INNOVATIVE CURRICULUM

Curriculum is regularly updated based on skill-level and understanding, and includes daily one-one-one sessions with instructors, group practice, and weekly presentations that showcase learning objectives.

PROGRAM STATISTICS

- **80** applications received.
- Applicants represented 28 states and 49 different universities, colleges and community colleges.
- 65% of applicants were male, 34% female, and 1% other.
- Participants represent 12 states and 15 different universities, colleges, and community colleges.
- 40% of selected participants are female.
- The student-to-teacher ratio is 1.5 to 1.
- 76% of applicants ranked their Chinese language skills in reading, writing, speaking, and listening as none or beginner.
- 15 participants were accepted based on GPA, personal essay, letters of recommendation, and previous experience.
