In keeping with recent board-certification guidelines making the master's degree the standard professional degree for athletic training, IUP launched the MS in Athletic Training in summer 2021. The program requires two full-time semesters and two summers and includes a sequential classroom and clinical curriculum. Students will progress through the program in a cohort. All cohorts begin in the summer. 60 credits must be obtained in order to graduate with a master's in athletic training.

### **PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS**

There are many ways you can enter the Athletic Training MS program. One option is to enter graduate school early, while still working on your bachelor's degree at IUP in the Kinesiology, Health and Sports Science/Pre-Athletic Training program. This option, typically described as a 3+2 option, allows you to begin your education for an athletic training career as a freshman and finish a year early with a master's degree, saving you time and reducing the cost of your total education. Students may also be accepted into the Athletic Training MS program after the traditional completion of a bachelor's degree either at IUP or at another college.

- Relevant— In addition to meeting the admission requirements of IUP's School of Graduate Studies and Research, students should also meet the entrance criteria.
- Supportive— Faculty are committed to your success.
- Inclusive—Applicants holding a bachelor's degree in KHSS/Pre-Athletic Training program can apply. Other majors can also apply as long as they include the required perquisite coursework (see program website for list).
- Field-ready Through our medical-based format, you'll learn to provide comprehensive client/patient care.

### **CAREER OUTCOMES**

Our Athletic Training MS program gives you a strong foundation for your career through a balance of both classroom and clinical training. Our program prepares you to take the Board of Certification exam and enter the field of athletic training. Individuals who currently hold a BOC credential or are BOC eligible are not candidates for this program. Comprehensive client/patient care consists of five domains in clinical practice: Prevention, Clinical evaluation and diagnosis in collaboration with a physician, Immediate and emergency care, Treatment and rehabilitation, Organization and professional health and wellbeing.
