PA OSHA CONSULTATION

REMEMBER....

- Keep tools clean and well-maintained
- Use the right tool for the job
- Follow manufacturer's operating instructions
- Utilize the guards and safety switches specified by the manufacturer
- Wear proper PPE
- Practice good housekeeping
- Keep work areas well lit
- Inspect tools frequently and ensure damaged tools are removed from service
- Keep all cutting tools sharp
- Disconnect when servicing to avoid accidental start-ups

- When using pneumatic tools, securely fasten the air hose to the tool and secure with a positive locking device
- For powdered-actuated tools never:
 - o load tools until just prior to use
 - o point tool at anyone
 - o leave loaded tool unattended
 - drive fasteners into materials that are very hard, brittle, or easily penetrated
 - o drive fastener into a spalled area
- For fuel powered tools, shut down and allow engine to cool before refilling fuel tank
- Never use compressed air to clean off clothing
- Before mounting abrasive wheels:
 - o Inspect and ring test
 - Verify the appropriate operating speed of the wheel
