Remember....

- <u>Employers</u> must:
 - Assess workplace
 - Eliminate and reduce hazards using engineering and administrative controls
 - **Provide** appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE)
 - PPE is the last level of control
 - Use Head Protection to protect from:
 - o Falling objects
 - Bumps against fixed objects, such as exposed pipes or beams; or
 - Accidental contact with electrical hazards.
- Use Eye/Face Protection to protect from:
 - o Airborne dust
 - o Flying particles
 - o Harmful chemicals
 - o Intense light
 - Welding
 - Lasers

- Use Hand/Arm protection to protect from:
 - o Severe cuts or lacerations
 - o Severe abrasions
 - o Punctures
 - o Chemical and thermal burns
 - o Harmful temperature extremes
- Use Foot & Leg protection to protect from:
 - o Heavy objects
 - o Sharp objects
 - o Molten metal
 - o Hot surfaces
 - o Slippery or wet surfaces
 - o Electrical hazards
- Body protection such as coveralls, chaps and impermeable full body suits, etc. may also be necessary depending on specific hazards
- <u>Employees</u> must:
 - o Properly wear PPE
 - o Attend PPE training
 - Care for, clean, and maintain PPE
 - Inform supervisor of needs for repair/replacement
