## Part II. Description of Curriculum Changes

- 1. ACCT435 Internal Auditing (a controlled major elective) will be eliminated from the undergraduate accounting program.
- 2. ACCT432 Forensic and Internal Auditing will replace ACCT435 as a controlled major elective in the undergraduate accounting program. The new ACCT432 will include significant instruction in a relatively new area of accounting practice, viz., forensic investigative auditing. Forensic accounting procedures primarily concentrate on fraud detection and prevention within organizations. This service represents a vital addition to the traditional duties provided by corporate accounting professionals to investigative authorities.
- 3. The proposed undergraduate accounting program revision will include ACCT432 as a controlled elective. ACCT432 will not affect any major requirements for any current accounting majors. In fact, some current accounting majors have already been given elective credit for the new forensic and internal auditing course when it was offered as a special topics course during the 1998 Spring Semester. Students who have previously completed ACCT435 prior to its deletion will continue to be given full major elective credit for the course towards graduation.
