LIBERAL STUDIES

I. CATALOG DESCRIPTION

SPAN 101: Elementary Spanish I 4c-01-4cr

For beginning students. Primary emphasis is on aural/oral skills. Students learn to converse and ask questions in simple present time and become acquainted with location of Hispanic populations and elements of their daily lives. Attendance is required. No student will be allowed to register for or take a D/F repeat in SPAN 101 when credit has already been received for a higher numbered course.

II. SUMMARY OF PROPOSED CHANGE

The only change is the addition of the statement about D/F repeats.

III. JUSTIFICATION FOR THE CHANGE

This restriction would prevent students from repeating this elementary course (SPAN 101) after having successfully earned credits in a course of more advanced level.
