Part II. Description of Curriculum Change

Catalog description

SPAN 384 History of Spanish Art

3c-0l-3cr

Prerequisites: SPAN 230 or equivalent, or permission

Exposure to the richness of art in the Iberian Peninsula and in particular in the area of Madrid and Castilla-Leon. Studies the evolution of Spanish art in history, giving more emphasis to contemporary tendencies.

The proposed change is to remove SPAN 260 as a prerequisite and to make an equivalent to SPAN 230 a possible prerequisite. The old catalog description was:

SPAN 384 History of Spanish Art

3c-0l-3cr

Prerequisites: SPAN 230 and 260 or permission

Exposure to the richness of art in the Iberian Peninsula and in particular in the area of Madrid and Castilla-Leon. Studies the evolution of Spanish art in history, giving more emphasis to contemporary tendencies.

Justification/rationale for the change:

The Department of Spanish determined that students who had taken SPAN 230 or earned credit for its equivalent were sufficiently prepared to take the courses in the Pennsylvania-Valladolid Program. SPAN 260 is a prerequisite for 300-level culture and civilization courses offered by the department on campus.
