Dr. McDaniel and Dr. Pistole,
I considered the question Dr. McDaniel posed to me yesterday, based on communication from Dr. Pistole. SPAN 362 and 364 are literature courses for majors and minors. They should not continue to be LS Electives because they do not fit well into any of the new LS categories.


Our majors in Spanish (BA and BSE) have not been and still are not able to count LS electives in their own major (with the SPAN prefix), so these courses need not be revised into the new LS curriculum.

Does our curriculum committee need to submit a proposal to have them removed from the LS Elective list? or will that happen by default if we do not revise them for the new LS curriculum?
