Justification/rationale for the change:

The Department of Foreign Languages determined that students were not adequately prepared for upper-level courses when they were allowed to participate in the Valladolid program without having taken SPAN 260 beforehand. Therefore, this proposal is to revert to the prerequisite in the catalog description that was in place before 2010.
