Course Syllabus

I. CATALOG DESCRIPTION

SP 385 SURVEY OF SPANISH LITERATURE

3 sh

Prerequisite: SP 230 and SP 260 or permission.

Students will be introduced to a general study of Spanish Literature from its origin to the present time. Students will learn to appreciate and analyze the different literary genres. Emphasis will be placed on 20th century literature.

II. COURSE OBJECTIVES

Students will recognize authors and general works of Medieval and Renaissance Literature.

Students will read and analyze the 19th century Spanish literature.

Students will analyze the literary periods of the Generation of 98, the pre-civil war and the post-civil war up to the present time.

Students will also be introduced to the masters of Latin American Literature of the 60's and the 70's.

III. COURSE OUTLINE

Presentation of Medieval and Renaissance works.

A selection of poetry of the Romantic period in Spain.

Major authors of Spanish Realism and the Generation of 98.

The importance of Pre and Post Civil war literature. The authors of this period as leaders of today's Spanish literature.

The literature of the transition, 1976 to the present, and the new trends in today's literature in Spain.

IV. EVALUATION METHODS

50% Tests. Two tests, midterm and final.

25% Class participation.

25% Research paper on one period, one author or one specific work.
