

Indiana University of Pennsylvania AY2022-23 and AY2023-24 Proposed Student Fees

Each year at the December IUP Council of Trustees meeting, a Student Fee Proposal book is presented. It includes any proposed changes to existing fees and proposals for new fees for council review and action.

Board of Governors Policy 1999-02A: Tuition was revised on July 10, 2019. This policy now requires the BOG to approve tuition rates for a two-year period, with the second year being tentative. Therefore, IUP student fee changes requested will be for two years, covering AY2023-24 and AY2024-25.

Unless otherwise noted, all approved fees will be effective beginning the fall 2023 semester.

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Indiana University of Pennsylvania Fee Analysis: Brief Summary

Academy of Culinary Arts

Supply Package and Baking Supply Package Fee

Students in the Culinary Arts program are assessed a Supply Package Fee, and students in the Baking and Pastry Arts program are assessed a Baking Supply Package Fee.

These fees are currently the same amount, and the request is to increase both fees from \$1,500 to \$2,000.

All first-year students in the Culinary Arts and Baking and Pastry arts programs are currently assessed a fee to cover the costs associated with the supply package the student receive in their first semester in the program. The current \$1,500 fee is paid by the students in four equal installments at the start of each semester. This request is to increase this fee from \$1,500 to \$2,000 and from \$375 per semester to \$500 per semester. No increase is being proposed for FY2024-25.

Supply Package – 2nd Certificate

All students who return for a second certificate in culinary arts are assessed a fee to cover the costs associated with the supply package they receive in their first semester in the program. The current \$500 fee is paid by the students in three equal installments at the start of each semester. This request is to increase this fee from \$500 to \$750. No increase is being proposed for FY2023-24.
